

THE FUTURE IS NOW WOODS OCK

History

The Woodstock Baptist church was first established on August 22, 1834, under the leadership of evangelist Elder Samuel Hartt. The first meetings took place in a carpenter's shop downtown, until the first meeting house was established in 1858. The meeting house was destroyed by a fire in 1881, but on August 2nd, 1885, a new structure was completed. That structure still stands today, and still serves as the foundation of our church. On February 10th, 1880, the Tabernacle Baptist Church (later known as the Albert Street Baptist Church) was formed under the leadership of Rev. George Seely. The Albert Street Church remained active until 1905, when the two churches joined, and formed the United Baptist Church, After the churches officially amalgamated in 1905, the Albert Street building was sold, and in 1908 the new church building was constructed to accommodate the combined congregations.

Since then, our church has undergone many renovations. A large expansion was added in 1959 with a focus on Christian Education, A restoration of the original stained glass windows was completed in 1993. In 1999, an elevator was added, and the facility was renovated with a focus on creating an accessible environment. In 2001, the parsonage was removed, and a parking lot was added. More recently, our audio-visual equipment was updated, giving our church the ability to live stream our worship service. As our church moves in to the 21st century, these blessings allow us to continue to follow the Lord's command to share the good news with all nations.

- A large 500 seat auditorium with a spacious stage that includes modern sound and lighting to enhance our worship experience through music, song, teaching and drama.
