Their ministry out of Costa Rica has local, regional and global impact through CETI (Center for Interdisciplinary Theological Studies). Please pray for David's travels this month. Victims of the Ethiopian Plane Crash

On Sunday, 157 people were killed in an Ethiopian Airlines crash. The victims were from 35 countries, and 18 of them were Canadian. Many were United Nations workers on their way to a conference in Nairobi. Investigators from Ethiopia and other countries, are looking into what caused the aircraft, a Boeing 737 MAX 8, to crash. Please pray for the victims and their families and that the cause of the crash is identified. This is the second crash involving this type of plane in the last six months. Please keep CBM's staff in your prayers, as many of them need to frequently travel. Give thanks to God for his travelling mercies.
