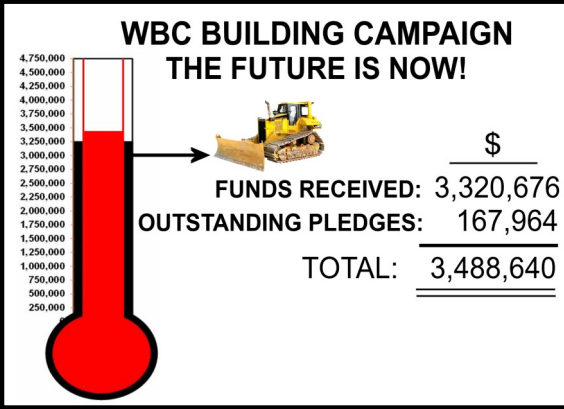

On the heels of a peaceful Canadian election season, please pray for other countries in the world that face unrest as civil society challenges corruption. Our colleagues in Lebanon, Hong Kong and Bolivia are all experiencing mass demonstrations and violent or potentially violent situations. In Bolivia, the national election is seeing unrest, with most major cities getting shut down and streets blocked. Please pray for protection for Field Staff in these nations, and for courage as they move in these countries as followers of Christ. Pray for God's justice, mercy, grace and peace in these nations and for each one's government leaders.
