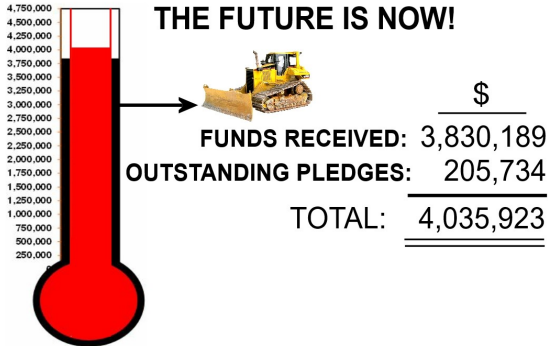

CBM PRAYERLINE

Pray with Terry Smith:

Our prayer draws from Isaiah 55:6-12

Seek the Lord while he may be found, call upon him while he is near; let them return to the Lord, that he may have mercy on them, and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the Lord. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and succeed in the thing for which I sent it.

For you shall go out in joy, and be led back in peace; the mountains and the hills before you shall burst into song, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.

Father of Light, we come before you today to ask your mercy and favour on our churches and institutions in our land. Lord too often we have dishonoured you by allowing the values of our culture - whether success or rivalry, pride or confidence, affluence or comfort - shape our engagement with you, with one another and with the world around us. We have broken our vows to love, support and care for the other. In seeking to show we are right, we have jeopardized the witness of the gospel through the unity of the Church. Lord, in your mercy, forgive us, we pray.

We affirm today that our ways are not always your ways, that our words are indeed not always your words. It is our prayer, Lord, that the truth of Scripture would not fall on infertile soil, that it would not return empty. We ask that together we would indeed go out in joy and be led in peace. Father, we pray this in your name. *Amen*
