

NOTICE OF MOTION

With the onset of Covid-19 a discussion was held in a Council Meeting to address how a Motion could be passed when in-person attendance is not possible for a Quarterly or Annual meeting. We reached out to the church legal counsel and amendments to our by-laws were suggested. These were presented to church members at our November Quarterly Meeting and tabled to be voted on at our Annual Meeting. As per the by-laws these are being presented to you prior to the Annual Meeting:

- Quorum for all business meetings shall include all church members who participate in and attend the meeting in person, or by alternative means of electronic media devices as are utilized from time to time by other organizations.
- Quorum for all meetings of Boards and Committees shall include all Church members who participate in and attend the meeting in person, or by alternative means of electronic devices as are utilized from time to time by other organizations.
- 3. To insure the integrity of the secret ballot, when the meeting is held virtually, the names of members who are in attendance and vote will be recorded so there can be no suggestion that a member can vote twice.
