Covid 19 Update #14 Woodstock Baptist Church June 30, 2020

The Psalmist very powerfully said: "O God, you are my God, earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water" (Psalm 63:1). The times we are living in are challenging—the land has become dry and weary—may we like the Psalmist long for God! May our desire to know the Lord be deepened. As our understanding of God is strengthened we come to rest in His sovereign love and care for us!

I am sure many of you have been wondering what our plan for holding public worship services in the church is. Our ministry team and Board of Deacons met and discussed plans for reopening for in person public Sunday Worship Services. At that time, we had a plan in place for summer ministry and a Covid 19 letter containing the details, ready to be sent on June 19. However, after the news conference by Premier Higgs and Dr. Jennifer Russell on June 19th announcing the removal of some restrictions, our plans required a rework. Thus, I have consulted other Pastors and our leadership and ministry team. The new plan is to take a methodical, slower, cautious, and guarded approach to reopening. Our denominational leaders recommend this same approach, staying a step behind government in reopening. For us, it is not a race to reopen and be first out of the gate to hold public worship services. The health and safety of our church and community is of utmost importance. Hence, Sunday, July 19th at 10:00 AM is the target date for reopening. In preparation, the trustees have been working diligently on a safety plan and procedures. Due diligence is of the essence. Regulations require that limited capacity, sanitization procedures and physical distancing measures be followed. Therefore, to attend the in person service on July 19<sup>th</sup> registering online or by phoning the church office will be necessary and will commence on Monday, July 13th at 10:00 AM. As well, Ministry and Sunday Mornings will have a different look. Please be patient with us as we navigate this new reality. I will send further details and instructions as we near the reopening date. In addition, please note, that should there be another virus outbreak, our plans could change guickly.

Even though we are soon reopening for one public worship service each Sunday with limited capacity, our plan in the short term is to continue to produce a quality on-line Sunday Morning Worship Service. This aspect of our ministry has grown and blossomed in ways we could never have anticipated.
